Key Scriptures

One night Joseph had a dream, and when he told his brothers about it, they hated him more than ever. "Listen to this dream," he said. "We were out in the field, tying up bundles of grain. Suddenly my bundle stood up, and your bundles all gathered around and bowed low before mine!" His brothers responded, "So you think you will be our king, do you? Do you actually think you will reign over us?" And they hated him all the more because of his dreams and the way he talked about them. Genesis 37:5-8 NLT

Meanwhile, the Midianite traders arrived in Egypt, where they sold Joseph to Potiphar, an officer of Pharaoh, the king of Egypt. Potiphar was captain of the palace guard. Genesis 37:36 NLT

The LORD was with Joseph, so he succeeded in everything he did as he served in the home of his Egyptian master. Genesis 39:2 NLT

... Joseph was a very handsome and wellbuilt young man, and Potiphar's wife soon began to look at him lustfully. "Come and sleep with me," she demanded. But Joseph refused. "Look," he told her, "my master trusts me with everything in his entire household. No one here has more authority than I do. He has held back nothing from me except you, because you are his wife. How could I do such a wicked thing? It would be a great sin against God." Genesis 39:6-9 NLT

Start praying. Be bold and pray with power.

Father, thank You for the work You're doing in our lives. Help us avoid getting too attached to our own dreams for the future. Instead, help us to look to You. Give us a better understanding of where You're leading us, and fill us with excitement for what awaits us in the future. In Jesus' name, amen.

Start doing. Commit to a step and live it out this week.
