TALK IT OVER

Key Scriptures

"For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also." Matthew 6:21 NIV

In the midst of a very severe trial, their overflowing joy and their extreme poverty welled up in rich generosity. For I testify that they gave as much as they were able, and even beyond their ability. ... 2 Corinthians 8:2-3 NIV

Remember this: Whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows generously will also reap generously. 2 Corinthians 9:6 NIV

Jesus sat down opposite the place where the offerings were put and watched the crowd putting their money into the temple treasury. Many rich people threw in large amounts. Start talking. Find a conversation starter for your group.

- Read Mark 12:41-44. What does this passage teach you about generosity? What might happen if you were to give more than you're comfortable giving?

Start sharing. Choose a question to create openness.

- Share about a time when someone was generous toward you. What was that experience like, and what did you learn about God's generosity?
- Talk about ways greed can keep you from God. How would your life look different if you chose to give generously, cheerfully, and faith-fully more often?

Start praying. Be bold and pray with power.

Father, thank You for showing us what it looks like to be generous. It's not always easy, but it's always worth it. Help us to be cheerful and faithful givers. Please show us how we can be generous this week so we can serve others and find freedom from greed. In Jesus' name, amen.

Start doing. Commit to a step and live it out this week.
