- The three ways of relating to money aren't three steps, they're made up of thousands of little steps. What's a next step you can take toward becoming a living sacrifice?

Start praying. Be bold and pray with power.

Dear God, You've given so much to me. Help me to be a cheerful giver like You. Please help me to notice opportunities to use what I have to make a difference around me, and increase my trust in Your provision. In Jesus' name, amen.
